WHAT CAN WE DO TO ENCOURAGE OUR CHILD(REN) TO READ?

- ❖ Limit your child(ren)'s television time! Set aside a quiet time for reading each day to fill the time usually spent in front of the TV.
- ❖ Be a good role model. Take your child(ren) to the fair or library and choose a book. This is great entertainment for the family.
- ❖ Encourage your child(ren) to read to you! If they are not yet reading, encourage them to talk about the pictures and guess what the story is about. Give praise to strengthen confidence in reading. Of course, you should still read aloud to them.
- ❖ Show an interest in the library books and classroom reading sent home. In this way, the home environment reinforces the skills learned in school.
